

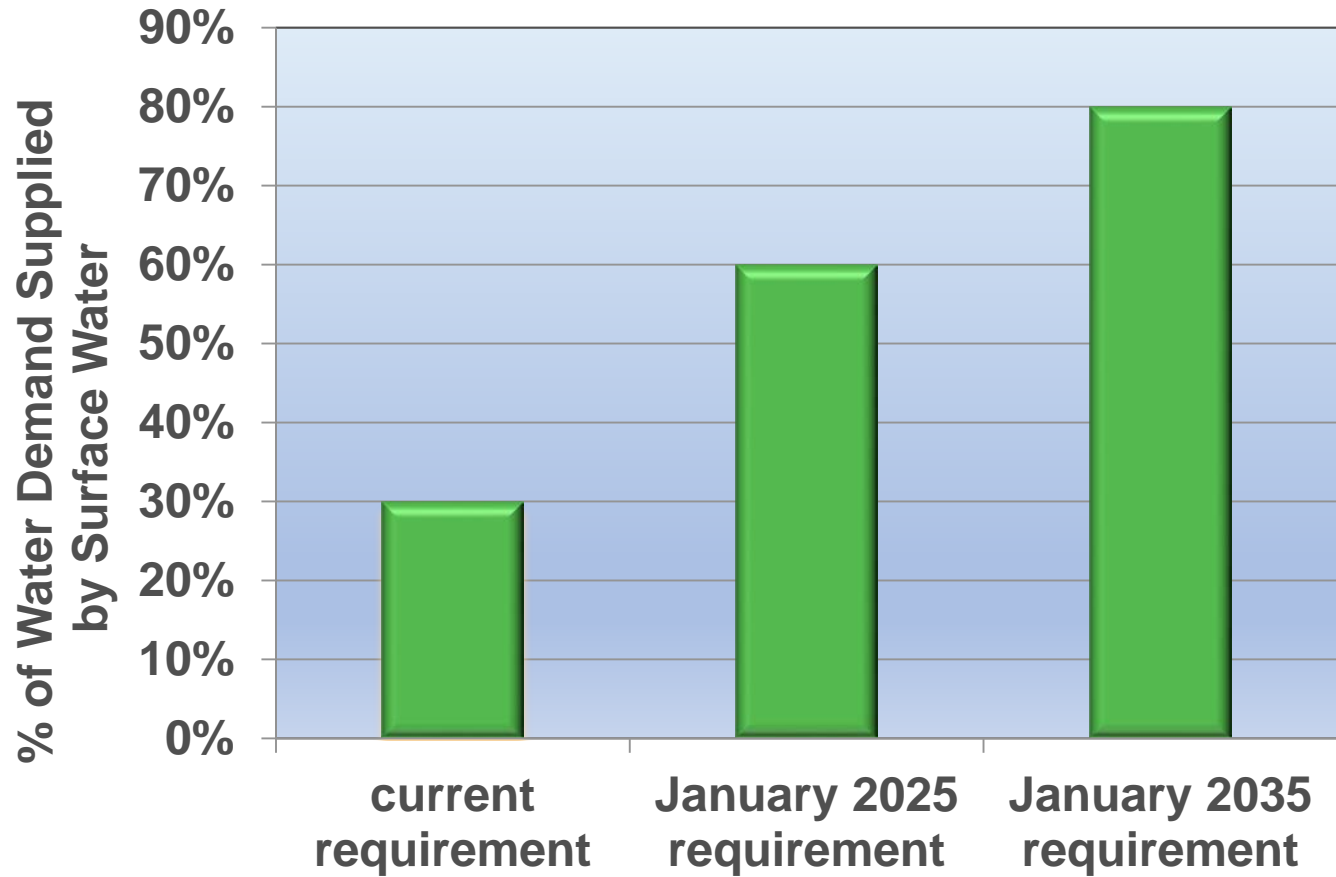

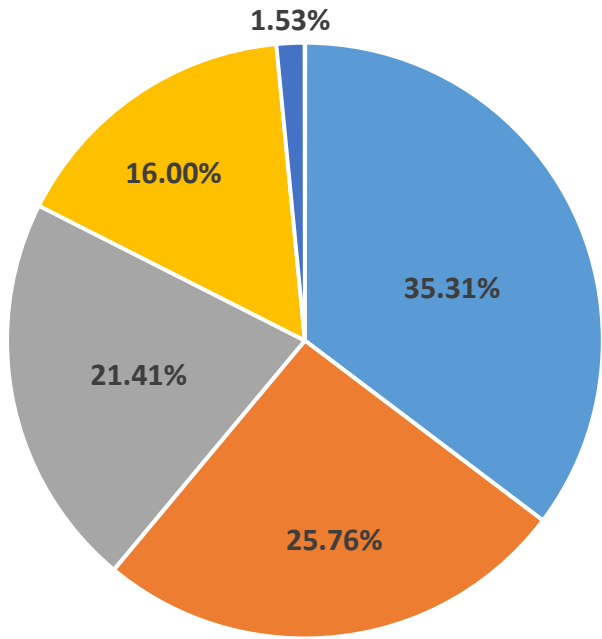


NEWPP Expansion Necessary for Growth & Subsidence Regulations



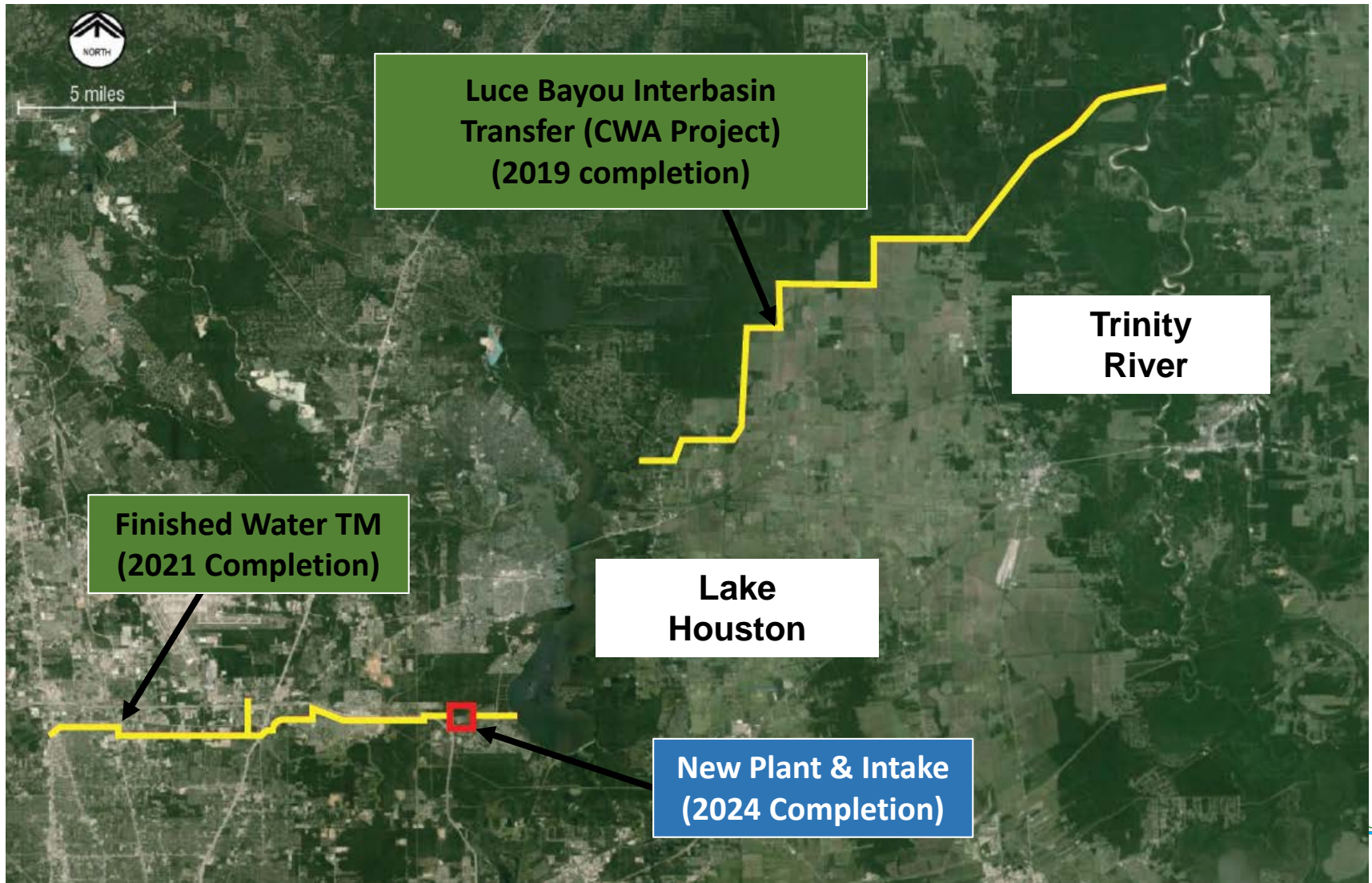

What Information is Available?

- **Neighborhood Impact** – traffic, dust, noise, lights, flooding
- **Jobs** – created and available as a result of this project
- **Transmission Pipeline** – the pipeline traveling west of the plant carrying the purified drinking water to Harris and Fort Bend counties
- **West Harris County Regional Water Authority** – one of the four water authorities responsible for this project and information on water subsidence and surface water mandates
