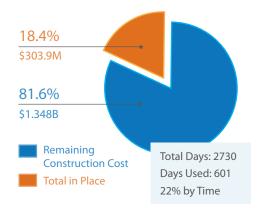

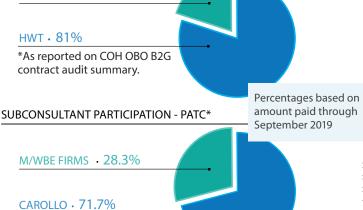

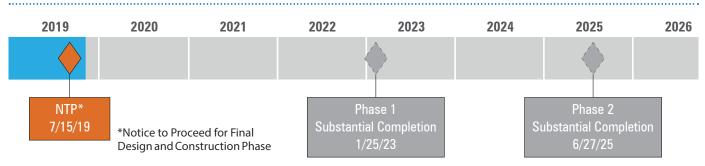

NOTEWORTHY ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- EWP1 punch list items ongoing; relocated soil stock pile and filled Pond 2
- Completed South Plant temporary power main feed.
- EWP 2 structural concrete work continues ahead of schedule. Installed pump cans for TPS.
- EWP4 welding and grouting of raw water pipe ongoing; initiated storm drainage tie-
- EWP6 North Plant vault stem wall and slab structural concrete work is proceeding on schedule.
- EWP6 IPS pump can installation initiated.
- Site work for administration building completed; trailer set-up and temporary power installation complete.

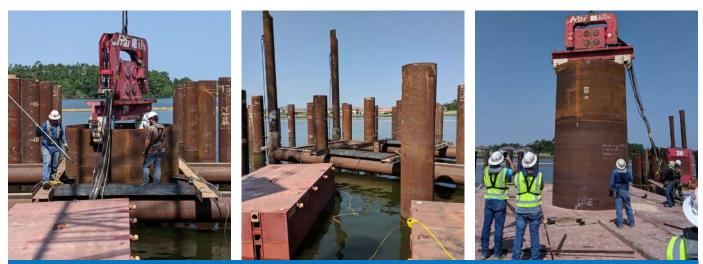
