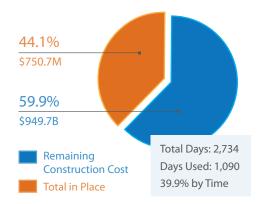

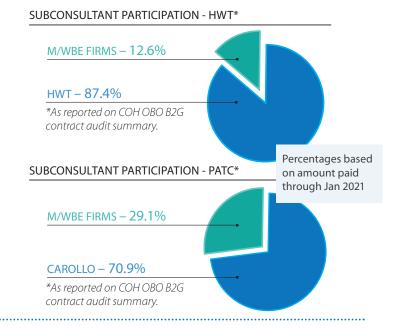


CONSTRUCTION STATUS*

NOTEWORTHY ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Central Plant: trough installation, BWA piping 281 filter module 1; ongoing masonry and wall placement facilities 291 and 292 transfer PS; masonry installation and SST tank fabrication facility 311 post-chemical no. 1.
- **North Plant:** ongoing structural for work all structures.
- **IPS:** ongoing installation of PS structural steel members, and precast building panels.
- Admin Building: completed installation of precast panels and ongoing HVAC and plumbing at Admin Building; initiated beam installation for Admin to Maintenance Building breezeway.
- **LREQ:** ongoing formwork and rebar installation main slab facility 602.
- Yard Piping: ongoing installation of 84- and 120-inch FW Corridor 5, 84-inch in Corridor 4, 96-inch OZW Corridor 3-1B, and various diameters Corridor 2-1AB.
- South Plant: pad placement GST 361 and installation wall and dome shoring GST 362; ongoing steel closure pieces facility 111 Main Switchgear Building, completed installations of all four centrifuges facility 520 dewatering building.
- **Substation and Site Electrical:** ongoing installation of duct bank and feeder cabling.

3-MONTH LOOK AHEAD

- Continue install 108-, 84- and 120-inch FW pipelines in Corridor 5 ongoing through April
- Install FW lines at Phase 2 GST area ongoing through March
- Install valve foundations and tapping saddles for 66" RW bypass pending through March
- Gravity Sludge Thickener Complex 2, Facility 502, continue equipment installation — ongoing through April
- Continue concrete wall and complete SOG placements at Gravity Sludge Thickener Complex 3 and 4, Facilities 503 and 504, and Service Buildings ongoing through May
- Complete slab on grade and wall placements to close up 242-Floc and Sedimentation Basin — ongoing through March
- Place foundations and containment walls for Chemical Facilities 213 and 214 ongoing through April
- Continue install wall framing, plumbing, HVAC, and exterior enclosure work at Administration/Maintenance building — ongoing through June
- Backfill HSPS 402 pump cans and begin suction piping ongoing through April
- Complete MSB 111 HVAC & lighting, perform breaker testing and energize MSB power gear ongoing through March
- Continue installation of process piping, electrical, and HVAC in solids Dewatering 520 — February through May
- Erect wall panels at GST 362 and place slab on grade for GST 361 ongoing through March
- Complete factory witness test of Vertical turbine Pumps for IPS and install ongoing through March
- Begin Field Acceptance Test of SCADA System ongoing though April
